

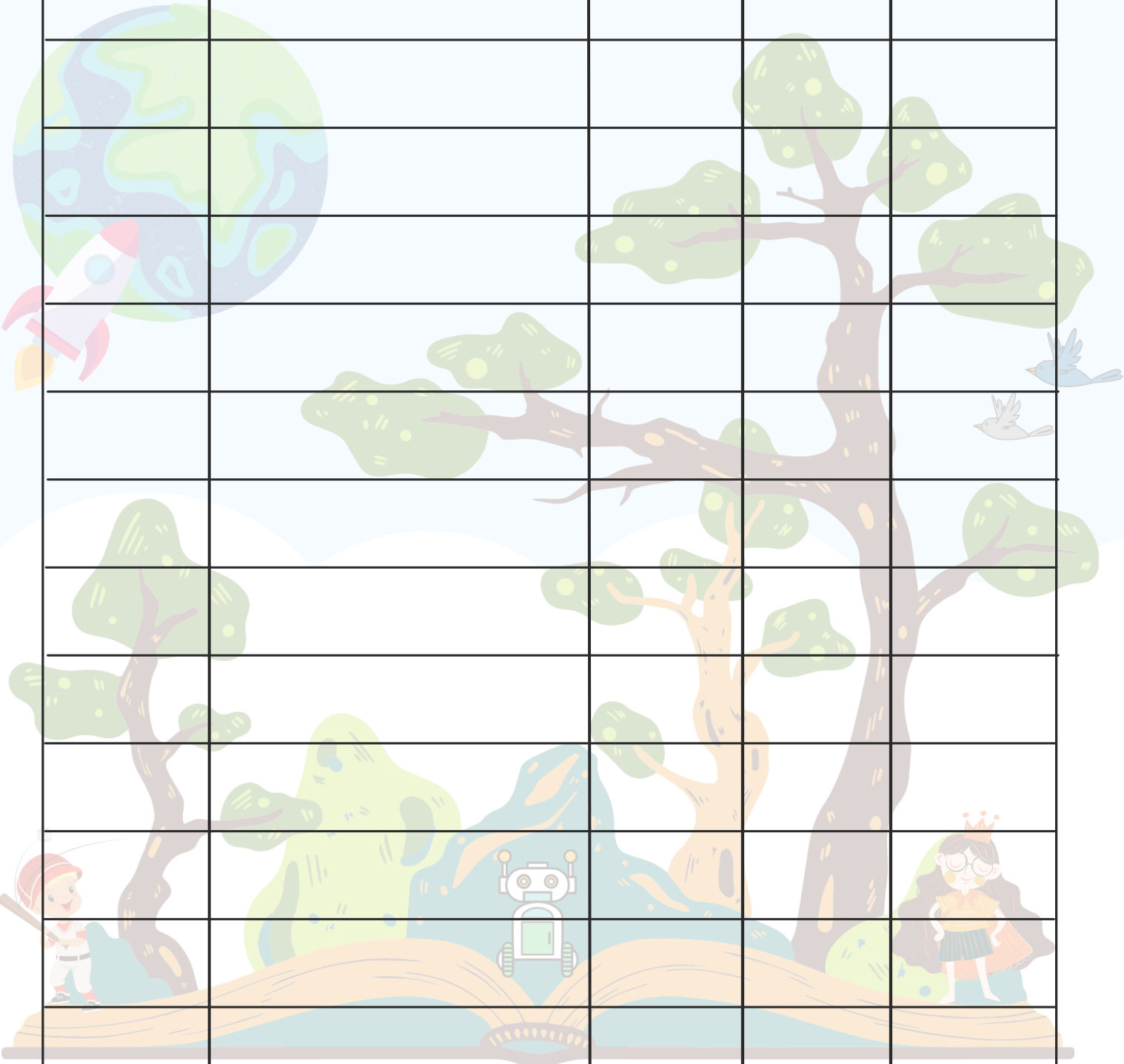

TRACK STUDENT'S READING

Keep track of reading minutes outside of school on the tracking sheet. Or use the google form online at <https://forms.gle/t3VBhURNZqpK78hK9>. If a scholar is not yet able to read alone, track minutes that an adult reads to them, or they may listen to an audiobook! Reading for a school assignment during school hours or for assigned homework does not count!

Bring the Reading Log to school on Friday 3/4 and turn into teacher. Students will have one last opportunity at school to log reading minutes on Friday in the Library.
