Welcome to Memorial Elementary PTO's Annual Family Giving Campaign, running now until November 30th! Your tax-deductible donation directly contributes to educational projects that provide a safe, beautiful, and fulfilling learning environment for everyone at Memorial Elementary.

This year, PTO will spend approximately \$300 per student to continue to offer the same level of programming and support we did last year. A list of PTO-sponsored projects & enrichments is attached. These fantastic offerings would not be possible without generous donors like you.

### This Year is Unique

In past years, PTO partnered with LIFT Memorial, a neighborhood non-profit, to provide support for the school. LIFT dissolved in February 2023 so that the efforts could be streamlined with PTO. LIFT's contribution to Memorial was over \$90,000 annually. We have them to thank for initiating the IB Certification process, library renovation, Mad Science, water bottle filling stations, Chromebooks, Clevertouches, and much more. Forever grateful for LIFT Memorial, we can carry on their legacy with your help.

As our enrollment increases and demographics change, in just one year, our school will likely lose \$35,550 in "small school" subsidy and Title 1 funds. As we navigate these funding reductions and changes, your gift is more important than ever.

### We Dream Big at Memorial!

Memorial PTO's overall fundraising goal this year is \$157,000. Not only do we plan to continue offering the existing great programs (see attachment), but also enhance the ways we support our faculty, staff, and students.

Specifically, this year we were asked by the faculty to provide some new tablets, Chromebooks, & Clevertouches. Not only do most of our peer institutions have a 1:1 student to technology ratio, but the changing landscape of learning demands that our students are technologically proficient.

Memorial PTO's projected annual budget is outlined here. The Family Giving Campaign spotlights two of these line items:

### IB Certification & Compliance - \$17,000

As a line item previously funded through LIFT Memorial, completing the certification process and continuing to offer an IB curriculum is a top financial priority. To enrich our curriculum and maintain IB compliance we added Spanish language ancillary class for the English-only classes. ### Garden Education - \$15,000

Previously funded by LIFT Memorial, the Tamela Hamilton Learning Garden upkeep and ancillary class is one of the students' favorite activities. Taking intentional time to be outside, engage with the natural world, and experience and the vitality of plant life is a unique opportunity made possible through parents and community members.
